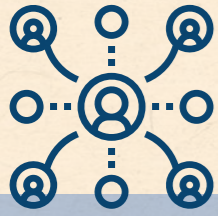

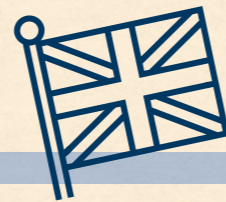

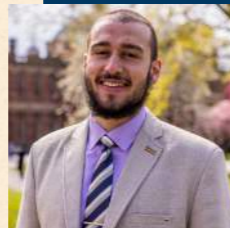

AM I ELIGIBLE?

To submit an eligible Chevening Scholarship application, you will:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country or territory, and agree to return there for a minimum of two years after completing your scholarship.
- Have completed an undergraduate degree that will enable you to apply for a postgraduate course at a UK university.
- Have at least two years' work experience.
- Not have previously studied in the UK through a UK government-funded scholarship.

There is no upper age limit.

- Name two referees for your application.
- Apply online between 3 August and 2 November 2021 at chevening.org/apply

You must have received an unconditional offer from at least one of your three master's course choices.
